

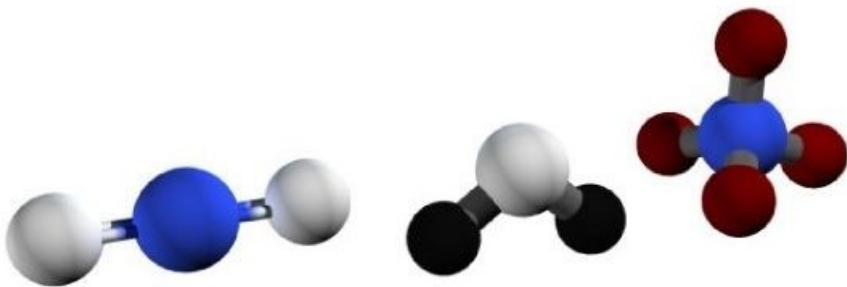

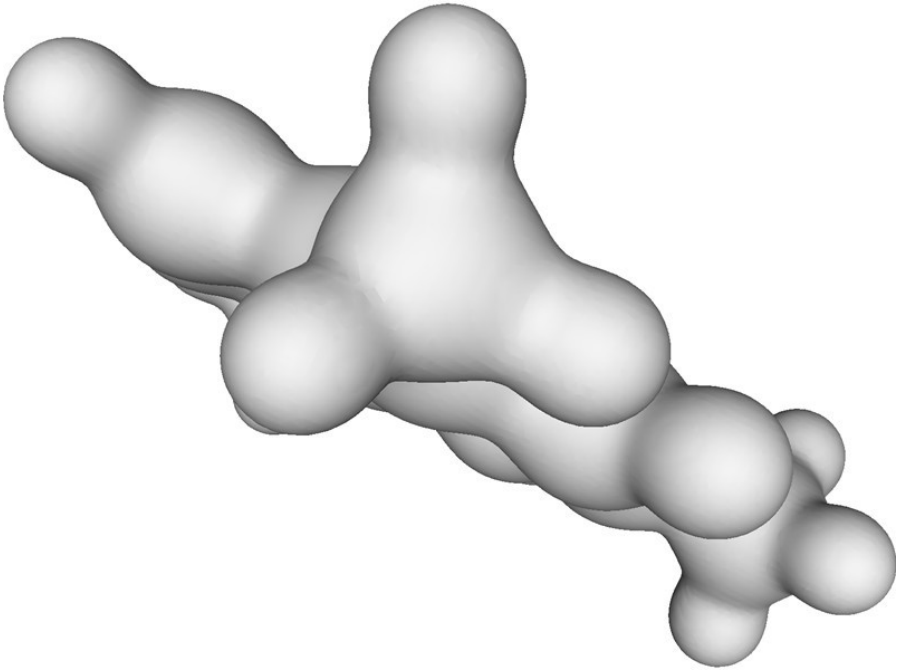
On the Theoretical Positioning of Appropriative Design

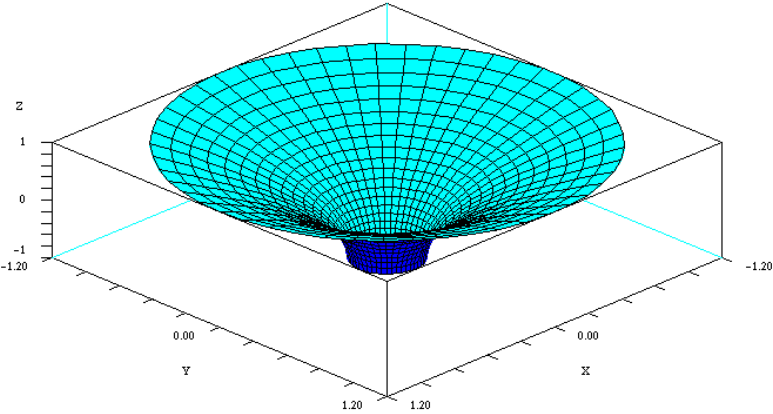

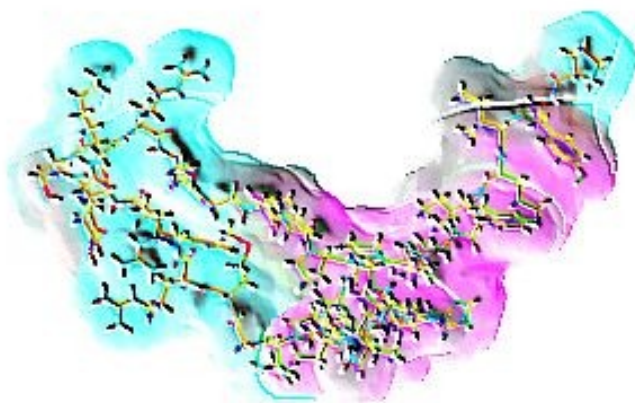
The Kombucha Soul as Diagrammed in Probability Clusters



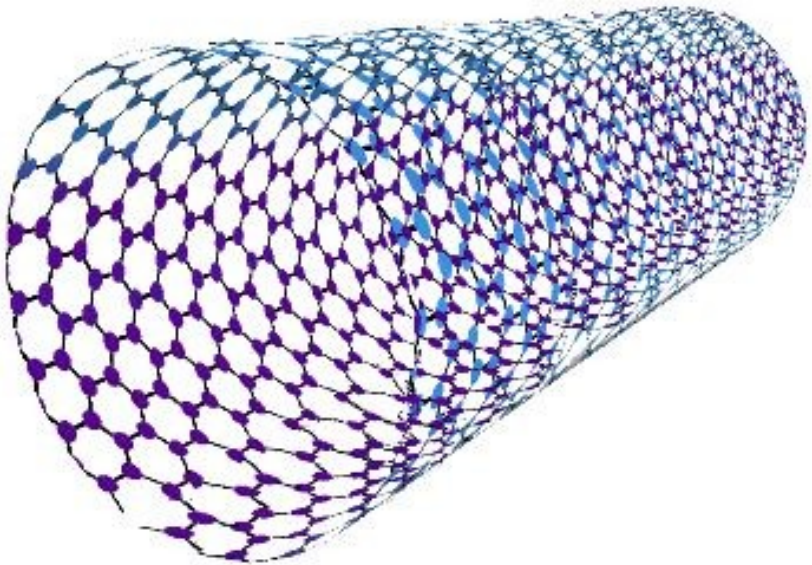

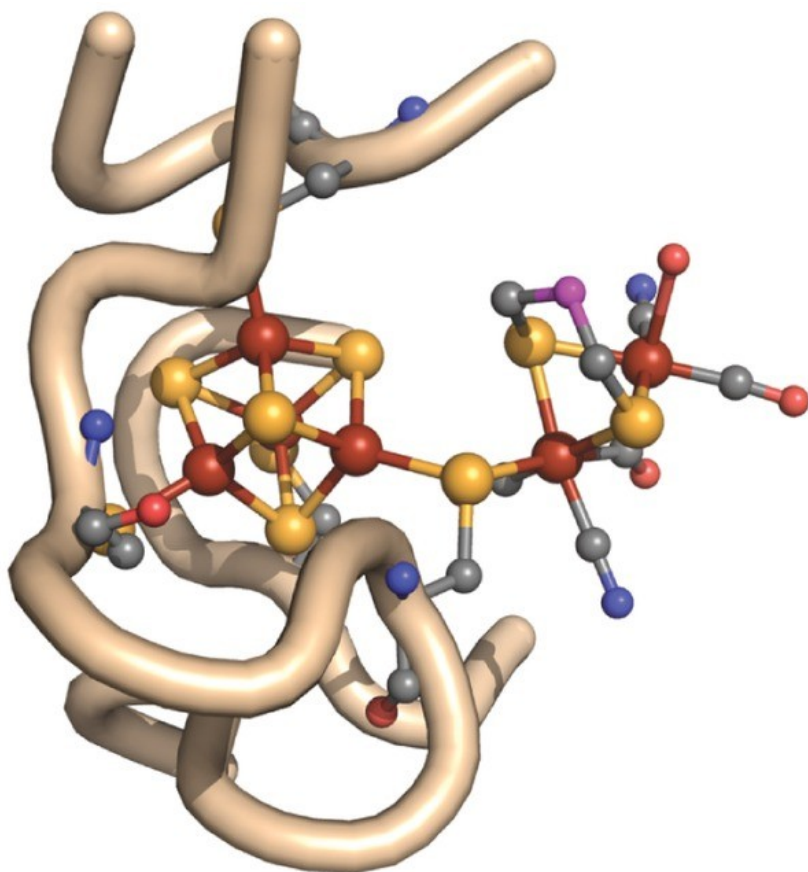

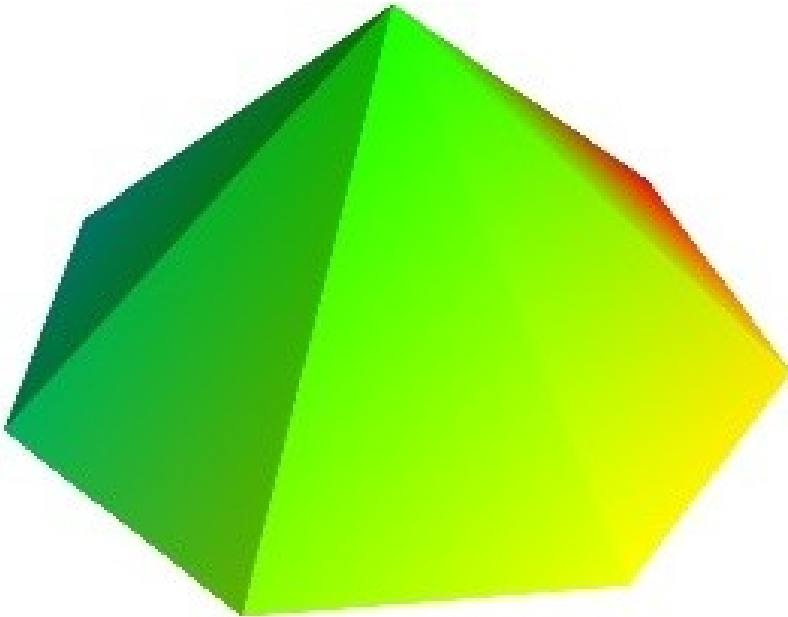
Torso Layering



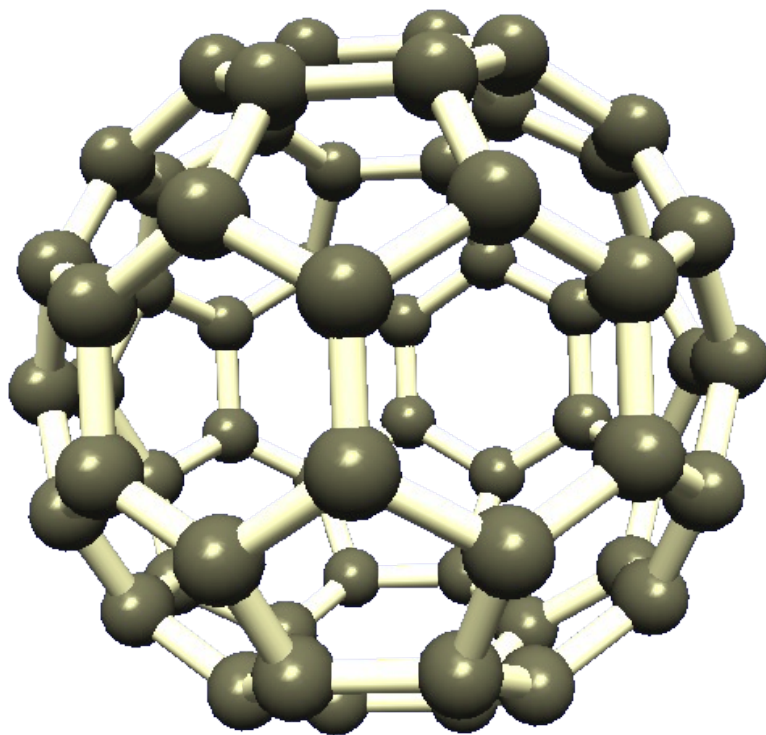
